My Campus Pass—Keeping each other safe during the pandemic is a shared and serious personal responsibility. As of Monday, September 28, employees and students are required to use the self-screening application My Campus Pass when traveling to campus or entering a Rutgers building.



You will be asked simple questions about your current health as well as what locations you will be in. You can access My Campus **Pass** by logging into my.rutgers.edu. If you are using a mobile device, bookmark this link https://go.rutgers.edu/checklist. Once you submit your survey, you will receive an immediate notification as to whether you've been cleared for entry.

This year, Open Enrollment for medical, prescription, and dental insurance coverage through the State Health Benefits Program (SHBP) will be completed online through **Benefitsolver** available on the **MyNewJersey portal**. Paper forms will no longer be accepted.

Enrollment or changes to retirement plans (i.e. 401(a), 403(b), and/or 457, and all other voluntary plans), Flexible Spending Accounts, and Voluntary Retirement Savings Plans will continue to be handled through University Human Resources.
